Board discussed importance of lunch room being returned to “intended status” after being used by MSA for exercise space. Some members seem to be under impression they cannot use space mid-week due to its use by MSA.

Mountain has suggested we are paying below what we actually consume for electricity. Therefore, separate metering for this will begin this year.

HOLIDAY CAMP:

Board agrees we should pursue offering this camp again this year. Must arrange with mountain sooner than later, as there were on-hill space issues last year.

COMPETITION ENHANCEMENTS:

Each discipline has a fund of \$2500 for purchasing enhancements items.

Snowboarding: Requesting starting gate and racing gates.

Both freestyle and snowboarding VP’s expressed need for radios and video cameras. This may be mountains responsibility because radios are for coaches and coaches are employees of Mt. Snow.

Elliot suggested that before disciplines use enhancement money to purchase items, that they first approach mountain to supply. If not, then ski club can decide if they will use enhancement funds to purchase.
